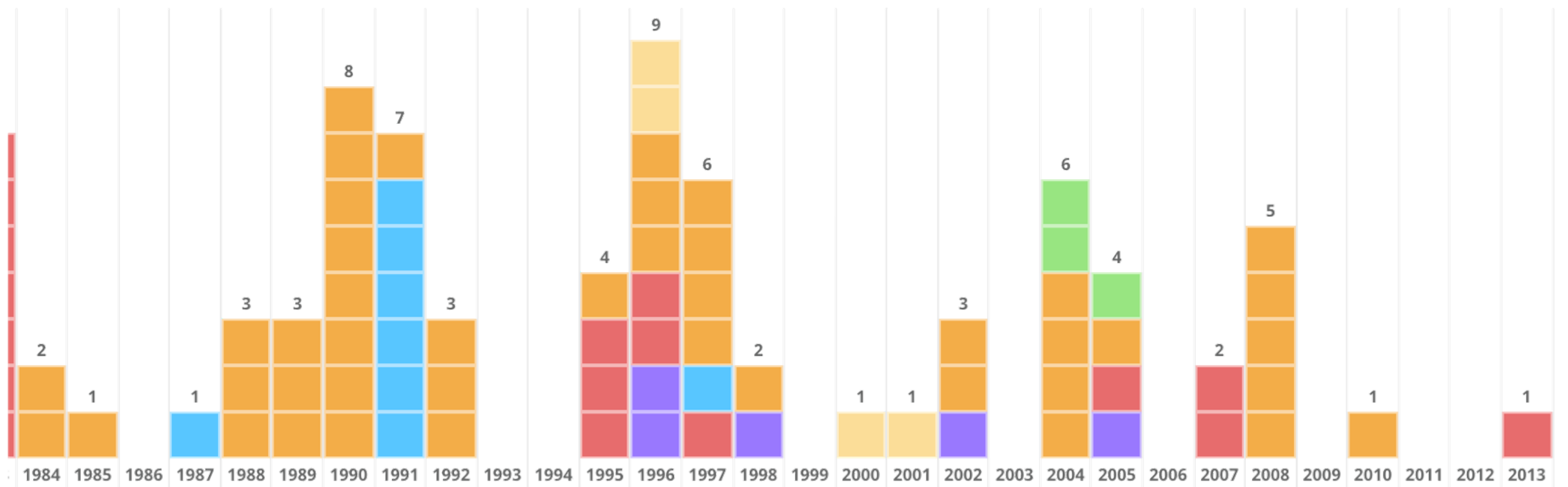


Miscarriages of Justice and Witness Testimony

Year of Conviction

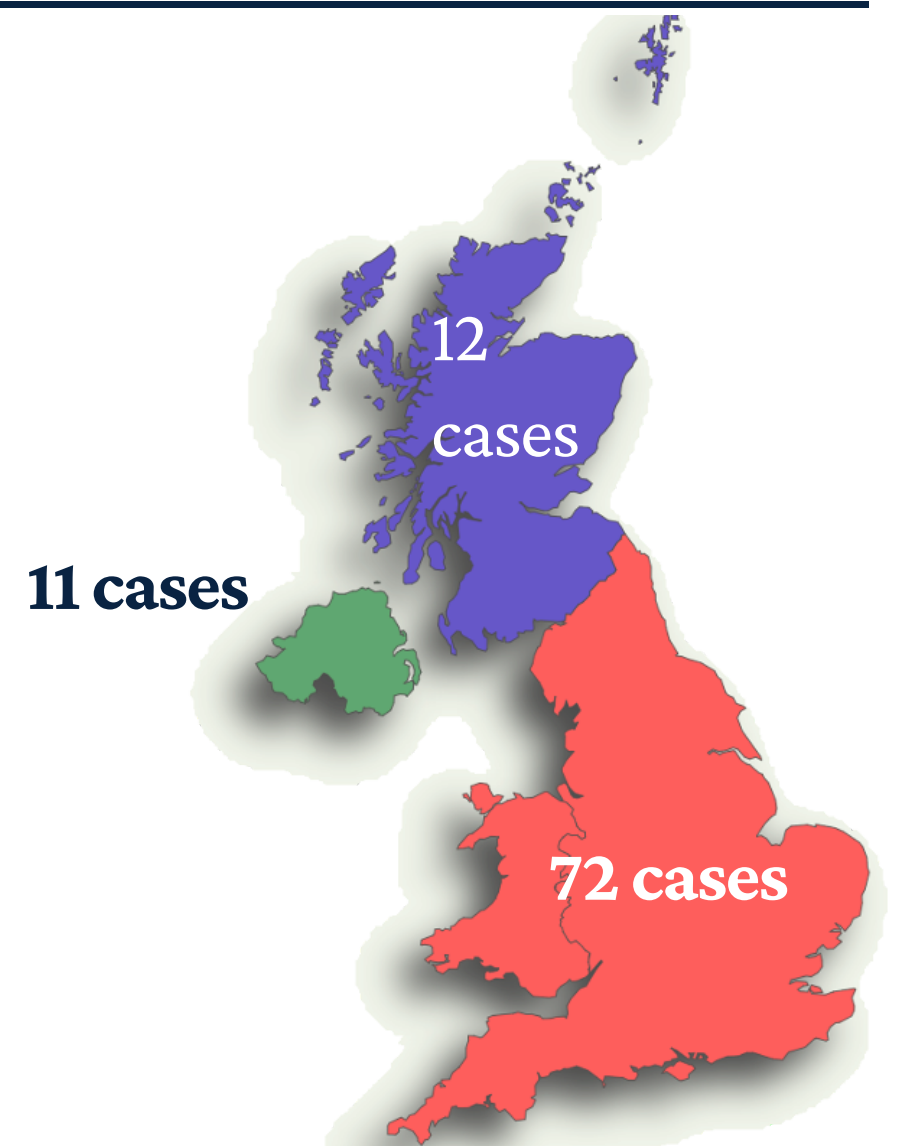


Types of evidence

- Informant or co-defendant** (34 cases)
- Eyewitness** (20 cases)
- Witness to alleged confession** (18 cases)
- Other**

Common evidence used on appeal

- 32%** Undermining the investigation
- 10%** DNA Evidence
- 77%** Undermining the witness testimony



Stephan Kiszko. Witnesses admitted they made up reports of suspicions behaviour.



Tony Poole & Gary Mills. Evidence suggested eyewitness lied, and police didn't disclose material undermining witness testimony.



Reg Dudley. Jailhouse informant admitted that he fabricated evidence in collusion with the police.
